	Floors: Vacuum and mop all floors, ensuring corners and edges are clean.	
	Light Fixtures: Dust and clean all light fixtures and switches.	
	Air Vents: Dust and clean any air vents or ducts.	
Bedrooms and Living Areas		
	Carpets: Vacuum carpets, and if necessary, arrange for professional steam cleaning.	
	Closets and Storage: Clean all closets, shelves, and storage areas.	
	Mirrors: Clean all mirrors, ensuring they are streak-free.

	Oven and Stovetop: Deep clean the oven, stovetop, and range hood, removing all grease and grime.

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Bathroom

Sink and Vanity: Clean and polish the sink, vanity surfaces, and mirrors.
Tiles and Grout: Clean all tiles, grout, and caulking.
Exhaust Fan: Clean the exhaust fan to remove dust.
Laundry Area
Washer and Dryer: Wipe down the exterior and interior of the washer and dryer.
Sinks and Cabinets: Clean any laundry sinks and cabinets.
